In the future, if you receive a missed call from the school, we would appreciate it if you would listen to the voicemail before calling the office to find out who called you. We use our "Connect-Ed" system to send mass phone calls and emails to all parents to keep them informed during emergency situations such as this one.

It also helps us to keep our phone lines open for communication with emergency personnel. If parents call in immediately after the Connect-Ed message is sent out, it ties up our phone lines and partially defeats the purpose for utilizing this system.

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENTS

- ☞ **Permit Renewals:** All permits expire this Friday, May 31st. You must pick up and complete a permit application from the school office if you plan to apply for a permit renewal for 2013-14. Approval of permit renewals will be based on satisfactory academic progress, behavior and attendance.
- ☞ **Enrollment:** New student enrollments can be completed in the school office (by appointment only) through Thursday, June 20th.
- ☞ **Lost & Found:** Please check Lost & Found racks (on the side of the cafeteria) before the last day of school. Any items not claimed by May 31st will be donated to a non-profit organization.
- ☞ **Uniform Sale:** School uniforms will be available for purchase on Wednesday, August 14th (the day before school starts) from 9:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. in the school courtyard (in front of the school office).
- ☞ **Volunteer Policy:** The district has modified its volunteer policy for 2013-14, and will now require **ALL** volunteers to be fingerprinted. If you plan to volunteer at all next year (even just once), please come to the school office to obtain the form you will need to take to the district's Human Resources department. It would be very helpful if you could complete the process during summer. If you are planning to assist in an instructional capacity, you will also need to provide proof of at least two years of college and/or pass the district's competency test. You only have to complete this process ONE TIME for as long as your child is continually enrolled in the district (including through high school).
- ☞ **Message from PTA:** Our PTA would like to thank all students and parents for their support throughout the year. One easy way to continue supporting PTA is to collect and submit Box Tops for Education. This year, PTA exceeded their goal and raised a total of \$1,519 through the Box Tops program.
